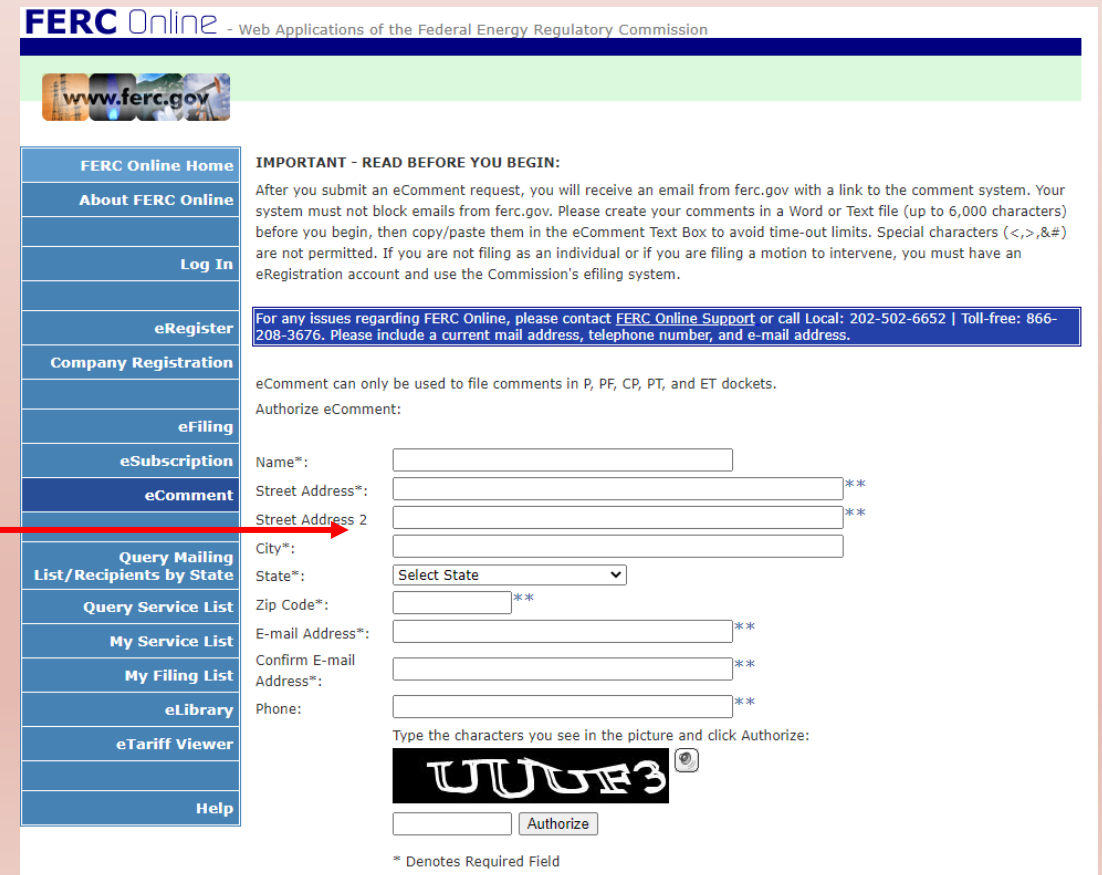
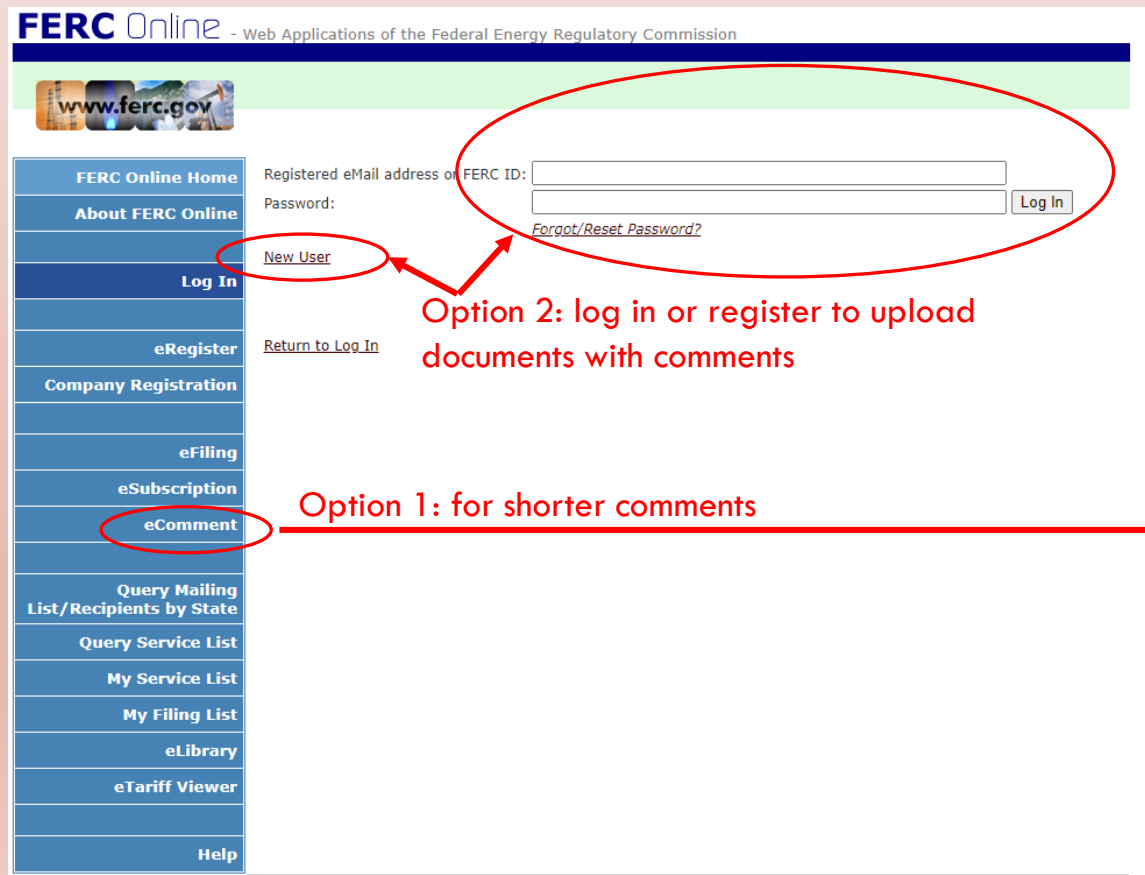

# FILING COMMENTS WITH FEREC, CONTINUED

- There are two ways to file comments with FEREC:
  - 1. By typing shorter comments into the “eComment” form (comment entries are limited to 6,000 characters).
  - 2. By logging in with a user ID and password to upload a document with comments (Word, PDF, etc.). You can easily create a new user account if you don’t already have one by clicking “New User”.



# FILING COMMENTS WITH FEREC, CONTINUED

- Option 2: after logging in to upload a comment document (Word, PDF)
  - Select Hydro: Licensing/Compliance, Licensing/Relicensing and Filing Type as appropriate, click next
  - On the next screen, type Docket Number P-14873, select the plus sign next to “Nushagak Electric and Telephone Cooperative, click next
  - On the following screens, you’ll be able to navigate to and upload your comment document, enter your email as signature, and submit
